DLF was founded in honor of their late son and brother, David, after he took his own life on January 4, 2016. For months prior to leading up to his death, David was the target of relentless and devastating cyberbullying that left him feeling isolated, depressed, and hopeless. David's Legacy Foundation's mission is to end, all forms of bullying, through education, legislation, and legal action. In 2017 Governor Greg Abbott signed "David's Law" which provides tools for educators, parents, and law enforcement to address cyberbullying. Together, Maurine and Matt continue a concerted effort to raise awareness through speaking engagements, advocacy efforts, and promoting student lead initiatives while sharing the message with young people that "It's Cool to be Kind".
